
ere in the Archdiocese of Portland, we've shown remarkable resilience.





Father Meeuwsen was ordained for the Archdiocese of Portland last May. The archdiocese currently has 46 men in the seminary, the most ever in the history of the Church of Western Oregon.

he first time I celebrated Mass, I was ready for the movement of liturgy, but I wasn't ready for the mystery of being opened as a priest. We had practiced so much at the seminary, but it wasn't real, and we all knew that. At my first Mass, when I held the Host up, I remembered the words of Thomas: 'My Lord and my God.' It hit me, slammed me. Without the ACA, I couldn't have afforded seminary tuition—no way, not on a Catholic school teacher's salary while still paying undergrad loans.



asically, our theme is a message of trust in God. Moses could have felt stupid hitting the rock with his staff, yet he trusted God and did that and indeed the water did flow. When we trust in our giving, in our living, God will more than do His part. Like in the Eucharist, we bring simple elements—bread, wine—yet God does infinitely more.

"During the past difficult times, we hoped and trusted in the Lord; and He has not let us down. As a Church family, we're profoundly grateful to continue the mission of Christ as we're called to do."






